## New buses PI and P2 STARTING OCTOBER 26

As part of the reshaping of London's bus services, there will be a reorganization of certain routes in the Surrey Docks area.

Two new routes, numbered PI and P2, will be introduced in place of existing routes 82 and 202.

These two new routes will introduce a new type of bus—single deck, one-man-operated—on which you pay as you enter. There will be a flat fare of 6d. Please have your fare ready as you board.

The buses on routes PI and P2 are new vehicles with new equipment for collecting fares, and we ask for the co-operation of our passengers until the new system has had time to settle down.

New bus PI will run daily. On Mondays to Saturdays buses will run on a circular route from New Cross Clifton Rise by way of Trundleys Road, Surrey Docks station, Galleywall Road, St. James's Road, Rotherhithe New Road, Surrey Docks station and back along Trundleys Road to New Cross. The Sunday service will be between New Cross and Rotherhithe New Road Canal Bridge only, running in both directions and not serving Galleywall Road or St. James's Road.

New bus P2 will run on Mondays to Saturdays only on a circular route from Rotherhithe St. Marychurch Street by way of Amos Estate, Rotherhithe Street, Surrey Docks station, Rotherhithe New Road, St James's Road, Galleywall Road, Surrey Docks station and back by way of Rotherhithe Street and Amos Estate to Rotherhithe St. Marychurch Street.

Existing bus routes 82 and 202 will be withdrawn and there will no longer be a bus service through the Rotherhithe Tunnel.
