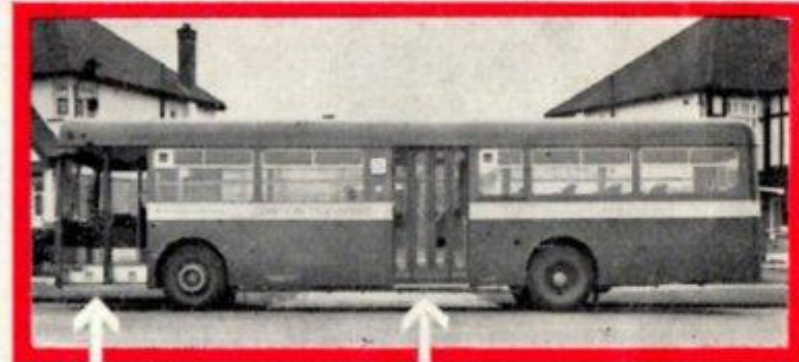

## How to use buses P1 and P2

1. The fare will be 6d. (children 3d.) paid to a coin-in-the-slot machine—sixpences or threepenny bits only. This is for any journey.
2. Please have your fare ready. The driver will give you change if necessary.
3. Get on the bus by the front entrance. Turn to your right and put your fare in the slot on the machine. This will release the gate, the 'ENTER' sign will light up and you can easily push through. **THERE IS NO TICKET.** Don't press the coin reject lever unnecessarily. It will only return your coin—it will *not* open the gate. Don't put money in while the 'ENTER' sign is lit. Children must press the button by the slot and then put in their coins. There are special arrangements for school children: children holding school Identity Cards must show them to the driver before pressing the child's fare button. If you hold a term ticket it must also be shown to the driver, who will release the entry gate into the bus.
4. You must leave the bus by the centre doors.



Board the bus here. Pass either side of the centre column. Please have your fare ready

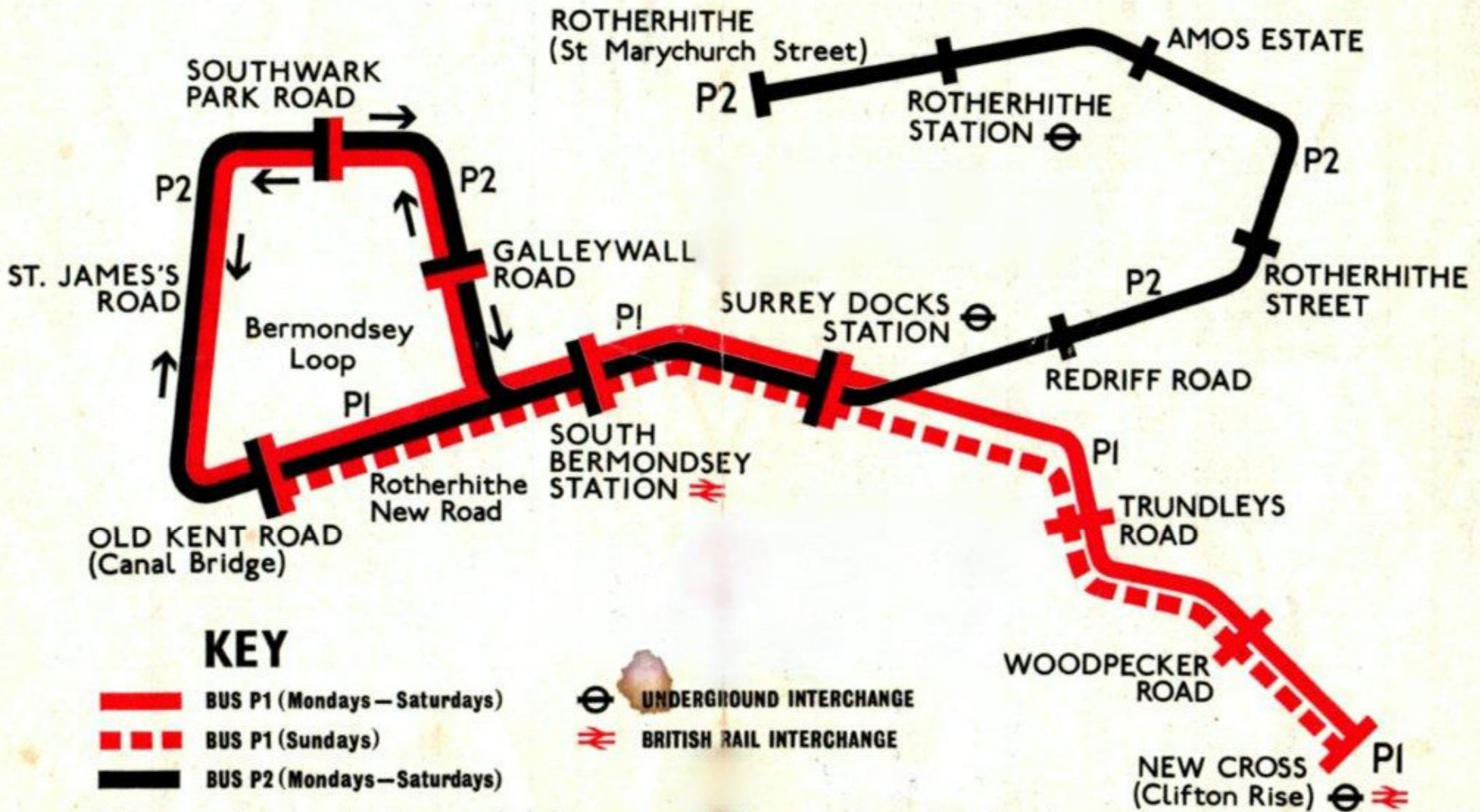
Leave the bus by the centre doors.
